- Albania, Algeria, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Republic of Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Jordan, Kosovo, Latvia, Lithuania, Lebanon, Libya, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Morocco, Netherlands, Norway, North Macedonia, Palestine, Poland, Portugal, Republic of San Marino, Romania, Serbia, Syria, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Swiss, Tunisia, Turkey, UK, Ukraine.

Eligible candidates shall send the following application material:

- A) **Portfolio:** documenting their research practice, their past and current projects, highlighting a confirmed interest in the cultural and artistic productions in the Mediterranean (compressed PDF).
- B) **Motivational Letter:** proving their specific interest in the project. (max. 2 pages);
- C) **This Application form**, duly filled in.
